


System Registration:

The following is a list of instructions on how to register and access the online modules for a course on www.learning.gaa.ie:

1. First the student must navigate to the GAA Learning & Development Portal by typing www.learning.gaa.ie into the web browser.





2. Register on GAA E-Learning Portal by clicking on 'Register' in the top right hand corner:
3. Fill in details. *NB Choose Registration Type 'Without GAA Membership Number' unless you have your GAA Membership ID to hand.*

4. A confirmation email will be sent to the email address you entered during registration, where you must click on the relevant link. (NB Some confirmation emails are arriving in Spam)
5. When you are redirected back into the site, the user will be asked to accept a Site Policy Agreement and then complete your 'Profile' by filling in the mandatory fields.

To Access a Course

1. Login to www.learning.gaa.ie using the username (email address) and password used during registration
2. Click on the 'E-Learning' black button on the right, as shown below:
