STADIUM SAFETY REGULATIONS St. Conleth's Park



- All persons entering this ground are admitted only subject to the following Ground Regulations and to the Rules and Regulations of GAA. Entry to the ground shall be deemed to constitute unqualified acceptance of all these Rules and Regulations.
- Fireworks, smoke canisters, bottles, glass, cans, flags, banners, poles and other similar articles or canisters including anything which could or might be used as a weapon, are not permitted within the ground and any person in possession of such an article or container may be refused entry or ejected from the ground.
- Spectators are not permitted to bring alcohol into the ground/area.
- The climbing of walls, stands, railings or other buildings in the ground is forbidden.
- Children must always be supervised.
- Under no circumstances is it permitted to throw any object onto the pitch.
- The instructions of the stewards must be obeyed at all times.
- Unauthorized persons are not permitted to enter onto the field of play and may be ejected from the ground.
- The GAA event promoters reserves the right for its servants or agents to remove from the ground any person who does not comply with the ground regulations or whose presence on the ground could reasonably be construed as constituting source of danger, nuisance or annoyance to other spectators.
- Smoking is forbidden in enclosed areas of stadium.
