Adoption of Standing Orders

For the proceedings of the Annual Convention to be carried out without delay, the following standing orders will be observed:

- a)** The Proposer of a Resolution or an Amendment thereto may speak for **2 minutes**, but no more than **4 minutes**.
- b)** A delegate speaking to a Resolution or of an Amendment must not exceed **5 minutes**.
- c)** The Proposer of a Resolution or an Amendment may speak a second time for **1 minute** before a vote is taken, but no other delegate may speak a second time to the same Resolution or Amendment.
- d)** The Chairperson may at any time he considers a matter has been sufficiently discussed call on the proposer for a reply, and when that has been given a vote must be taken.
- e)** A delegate may, with the consent of the Chairperson, move that “the question be now put”, after which when the proposer has spoken, a vote must be taken.
- f)** Where the Annual Convention considers it appropriate, a vote may be by secret ballot. This decision shall be made by a show of hands.
- g)** A speaker to the Annual Report or any other general discussion shall not exceed **2 minutes** to any one topic.
- h)** Any Motions to remove or amend an existing Bye-Law shall be carried by **three-fifths** of those present, entitled to vote and voting. This applies to motions to the Annual Congress also.
- i)** Standing Orders shall not be suspended to consider any matter on the agenda except by the consent of a majority equal to by three-fifths of those present, entitled to vote and voting.
- j)** The Chairperson may change the order of items on the agenda with the support of a simple majority of those present, entitled to vote and voting.

- (9) Communications Officer
- (10) Hurling Officer (if desired)
- (11) Provincial Council Representatives
- (12) Central Council Representative

* **Delivered Vote** - when a member, who has contested two or more positions, is elected to the first position, the votes gained by him in the election for the following Officership(s) shall not count but that member's number two and subsequent preference votes shall still apply.
