€21 Million Contract Signed for Páirc Tailteann Stand Redevelopment

Meath GAA today confirmed that contracts have been signed for the redevelopment of the stand at Páirc Tailteann, marking a significant milestone in the delivery of improved facilities for players, members, supporters, and the wider community.

The public contract signing took place on **Saturday, 10th January 2026** in **Páirc Tailteann, Navan**, with invited representatives from the GAA, local public representatives, and key stakeholders in attendance.

The stand redevelopment forms a core part of the ongoing improvement programme at Páirc Tailteann, aimed at ensuring the venue continues to meet modern standards for **safety, accessibility, supporter experience, and community use.**
